Referral Instructions & Eligibility Requirements**INSTRUCTIONS**

If you would like to refer someone to Transformation Works – Ventura County, please ensure that the individual is between the ages of 12 and 24 and currently resides in one of the Target Areas listed below (see Minimum Eligibility Requirements #1 and #2).

If the individual you would like to refer does meet the criteria outlined, please complete the Confidential Referral Form and email it to streetimpact@cityimpact.com.

Approval into the program will be determined by the Ventura County Sheriff's Office (VCSO) based on the below eligibility criteria and other factors (e.g., criminal record, incidence of violence, police citations, etc.). If the Referral is approved, the referred individual will be contacted and asked to complete an application form for the Transformation Works – Ventura County program. You will be notified by if the referral is declined.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**Minimum Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Youth is 12 to 24 years of age
2. Current resident in one of the Target Cities/Areas: Oxnard, Port Hueneme, El Rio, Saticoy, Ventura, Santa Paula, Fillmore, Piru

Additional Eligibility Considerations/Risk Behaviors:

3. Suspicious behavior related to violent crime or substance abuse
4. School discipline records (due to violence, weapons, or drugs)
5. Youth has been arrested for weapon related activities
6. Youth has a criminal record
7. Youth has police citations
8. Youth is on probation (for gang terms and/or weapons related activities)
9. Youth is re-entering after incarceration
10. Youth is involved with one of the two county Gang-Injunctions (i.e., Colonia Chiques or Southside Chiques)
11. Gang member/gang affiliate – youth is believed to be in a gang or a gang affiliate
12. High-Risk for gang involvement
 - Tag-Bangers
 - Youth who hang out with known gang members on a daily/weekly basis
 - Youth involved with acts of violence on school campuses that lead to major suspensions or expulsions
 - Youth who were victims of violence and show signs of retaliation
13. Family history of gang involvement
 - Family member(s) is a high ranking gang member
 - Family member(s) in the house are known gang members
 - Family member(s) who interacts with the youth on a weekly basis is/are a known gang member
